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MINUTES of the GOVERNING BOARD of the WILDLIFE CORRIDOR CONSERVATION AUTHORITY

May 27, 2009

I. Call to Order.

The special meeting of the Governing Board of the Wildlife Corridor Conservation Authority (WCCA) was called to order by Chairperson Glenn Parker at 7:44 p.m. on May 27, 2009 in the Council Chambers, Whittier City Hall, 13230 E. Penn Street, Whittier, California.
